#### **Make Up Work:**

A. After an absence, a student must arrange with the teacher for any make up work. Students have the same number of days they were absent to make up their work except in the instance of some long-term secondary school assignments.

B. If a secondary teacher assigns a long-term project (when a student has ten (10) or more school days to complete the work) and gives students advance written notice that even in the event of an absence the project is due on the first day the student returns, then the student is expected to fulfill that requirement unless the principal determines there are mitigating circumstances and approves an extension. If the work is submitted after the first day back to school it may be dropped no more than one (1) letter grade for each additional day.

C. Work made up after an UNEXCUSED absence (such as an out-of-school suspension) may be dropped a letter grade in an elementary or middle school and must be dropped a letter grade in a high school.
